ATTENDANCE POLICY	<p>Because of the length of the class period (3 hours) and the shortness of the summer school semester, students are required to attend class a minimum number of days in order to meet the high school accreditation standards. Therefore, students may miss no more than 2 days of summer school. A student will be withdrawn on the third absence. All absences (excused and unexcused) count towards the attendance policy. There will be no refunds or exceptions made.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Bell rings-30 minutes late to class = 1 tardy 3 tardies = 1 absence More than 30 minutes late to class = 1 absence</p>						
LUNCH	The school cafeteria does not sell lunch during summer school. However, different vendors (pizza, chicken sandwiches, etc.) are usually set up in the cafeteria and sell lunch items to students. Students may also bring their lunch from home. Students who are on campus for 1st and 2nd period classes should not leave campus between classes for any reason, or they will be considered AWOL. There is not enough time between classes to go out somewhere to eat.						
TRANSPORTATION	There is NO transportation provided for summer school. You must provide your own transportation to the summer school site. You should not arrive more than 10 minutes early and you must exit the campus immediately after dismissal.						
END OF COURSE TESTS	Students enrolled in the second semester of Technical or College Prep classes in Freshman or Junior English, Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, Economics or US History will be required to take the state mandated end of course test in that subject. These tests will count 15% of the final grade.
